Form Design

When creating a form in Access from the form wizard, there are four different layout options to choose from: **Columnar, Tabular, Datasheet,** & **Justified**.

- Columnar and Justified are both single-record views, meaning they display one record at a time.
- Tabular and Datasheet are both spreadsheet views, meaning they display many records like an
 Excel spreadsheet.

Figure 1: The Form Wizard





Figure 2: Columnar

Figure 3: Justified




Justified displays the single-record view horizontally.

Tabular displays the data in spreadsheet view with borders and a form header.

Datasheet displays the data in spreadsheet view with banded rows, no borders, and no form header.
